### **Motions**

#### **Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance**

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the Electoral Affairs Commission (Financial Assistance for Legislative Council Elections)(Application and Payment Procedure) Regulation, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 269 of 2003 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 7 January 2004, be amended -

(a) in section 4 -

(i) in subsection (1) -

(A) in paragraph (a), by adding "or his agent" after "form";

(B) in paragraph (b), by adding "or the agent of one of the candidates" after "form";

(ii) by adding -

"(3) The claim form must be presented within the period or extended period provided for in section 37 of the Elections (Corrupt and Illegal Conduct) Ordinance (Cap. 554) for lodging an election return.";

(b) in section 7(4) -

(i) in paragraph (a), by adding "or his agent" after "notice";

(ii) in paragraph (b), by adding "or the agent of one of the candidates" after "notice";

(c) in section 10(3), by adding "or the agent of one of the candidates" after "form".

Question on the motion proposed.

Hon HUI Cheung-ching, Chairman of the Subcommittee on subsidiary legislation relating to 2004 Legislative Council elections, spoke on the motion.

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

### **Members' Motions**

#### **Drawing up the blueprint for Hong Kong's social welfare policies for the next decade**

Hon CHAN Yuen-han moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council urges the Government to draw up the blueprint for the development of Hong Kong's social welfare policies for the next decade, so as to tie in with the economic and social changes in the territory and formulate social welfare policies that meet the needs of the public.

While Hon CHAN Yuen-han was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 4:40 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong moved the following amendment to Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion and addressed the Council:

To add ", with full participation of social service agencies, their employees, service users, the industrial and commercial sectors and the public" after "for the next decade".

Question on Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's amendment to Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion proposed.

13 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon CHAN Yuen-han spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 6:23 pm, while the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Question on Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong's amendment to Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion put and agreed to.

Hon CHAN Yuen-han replied.

Question on Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion as amended by Dr Hon LAW Chi-kwong put and agreed to.

**Immediately consulting the public on election by universal suffrage**

Hon Andrew CHENG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council regrets that the Task Force on Constitutional Development's trip to Beijing lacks transparency and urges the Government to immediately consult the public on whether the Chief Executive and all Members of the Legislative Council should be elected by universal suffrage in 2007 and 2008 respectively, collate the public's views received in an impartial manner, and accurately relay them to the Central Government.

Question on Hon Andrew CHENG's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Howard YOUNG and Dr Hon YEUNG Sum would move amendments to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the two amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Howard YOUNG and Dr Hon YEUNG Sum spoke respectively on the motion and their amendments.

16 Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Andrew CHENG spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Howard YOUNG moved the following amendment to Hon Andrew CHENG's motion:

To delete "regrets that" after "That this Council" and substitute with "urges"; to delete "Development's trip to Beijing lacks transparency and urges the Government to immediately" after "the Task Force on Constitutional" and substitute with "Development to expeditiously"; to delete "whether the Chief Executive and all Members of the Legislative Council should be elected by universal suffrage in" after "consult the public on" and substitute with "the constitutional developments for"; and to delete "public's" after "collate the".

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's amendment to Hon Andrew CHENG's motion proposed and put.

Hon Andrew CHENG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, 17 were in favour of the amendment and eight against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 23 were present, nine were in favour of the amendment and 13 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU rose to move the following motion without notice:

That in the event of further divisions in respect of the motion on Immediately consulting the public on election by universal suffrage or its other amendments, the Council do

proceed to each of such divisions immediately after the division bell has been rung for one minute.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum moved the following amendment to Hon Andrew CHENG's motion:

To delete "regrets that" after "That this Council" and substitute with "urges"; and to delete "Development's trip to Beijing lacks transparency and" after "the Task Force on Constitutional" and substitute with "Development to increase the transparency of its discussions with the Central Government, and also".

Question on Dr Hon YEUNG Sum's amendment to Hon Andrew CHENG's motion proposed and put.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, six were in favour of the amendment and 19 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 24 were present, 13 were in favour of the amendment and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Andrew CHENG replied.

Question on Hon Andrew CHENG's motion put.

Hon Andrew CHENG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, five were in favour of the motion and 20 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 24 were present, 13 were in favour of the motion and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

**Next Meeting**

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 3 March 2004 at 2:30 pm.

The Council was adjourned at 9:21 pm.
