Bills

Hong Kong Sports Development Board (Repeal) Bill

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 26 November 2003 resumed.

Hon NG Leung-sing, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Hong Kong Sports Development Board (Repeal) Bill, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, he spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

Five more Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Home Affairs replied.

Question on the Second Reading put.

Hon Andrew CHENG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 46 Members were present, 32 were in favour of the motion and 13 against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Hong Kong Sports Development Board (Repeal) Bill.

Question that clauses 1 to 8, 10, 11 and 13 to 17 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 9 and 12 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Home Affairs moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 9 and 12, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

New clause 9A read the first time.

The Secretary for Home Affairs moved the Second Reading of new clause 9A.

Question on the Second Reading of new clause 9A proposed, put and agreed to.

New clause 9A read the second time.

The Secretary for Home Affairs moved the addition of new clause 9A to the Bill.

Question on the addition proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Home Affairs reported that

the Hong Kong Sports Development Board (Repeal) Bill

had passed through the Committee with amendments. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Airport Authority (Amendment) Bill 2004

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 24 March 2004 resumed.

Hon SIN Chung-kai, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Airport Authority (Amendment) Bill 2004, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, he spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

Two more Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Airport Authority (Amendment) Bill 2004.

Question that clauses 1 and 2 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury reported that

the Airport Authority (Amendment) Bill 2004

had passed through the Committee without amendment. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Motions

<u>Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General</u> Clauses Ordinance

The Secretary for Education and Manpower moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that the Education (Exemption)(Private Schools Offering Non-Formal Curriculum) Order, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 76 of 2004 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 12 May 2004, be amended -

- (a) in Schedule 2, in section 7(b) of Part 2, by adding before the semicolon "or under the Prevention of Child Pornography Ordinance (Cap. 579)";
- (b) in Schedule 3, in section 6(b) of Part 2, by adding before the semicolon "or under the Prevention of Child Pornography Ordinance (Cap. 579)".

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

As the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works, who was to move the next motion, was not in the Chamber, the President suspended the meeting at 5:30 pm.

The Council resumed at 5:40 pm.

<u>Proposed resolution under the Fixed Penalty (Criminal Proceedings)</u>

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved -

- (a) that the Schedule to the Fixed Penalty (Criminal Proceedings) Ordinance be amended, in item 53, by adding "private" before "light"; and
- (b) that this Resolution shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works by notice published in the Gazette.

Question on the motion proposed.

Hon Miriam LAU spoke on the motion as Chairman of the Subcommittee on Proposed Resolution under section 12 of the Fixed Penalty (Criminal Proceedings) Ordinance, and then in her personal capacity as a Member.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Members' Bills

First Reading

Wing Hang Bank, Limited (Merger) Bill

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President stated that as the Wing Hang Bank, Limited (Merger) Bill presented by Dr Hon David LI related to Government policies, in accordance with Rule 54(1) of the Rules of Procedure, the signification of the written consent of the Chief Executive by a designated public officer was required before the Council entered upon consideration of the second reading of the Bill.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury confirmed that the Chief Executive had given his written consent for the Wing Hang Bank, Limited (Merger) Bill to be introduced into this Council.

Second Reading

Wing Hang Bank, Limited (Merger) Bill

Dr Hon David LI moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

<u>Proposed resolutions under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance</u>

1. Electoral Affairs Commission (Electoral Procedure) (Legislative Council) (Amendment) Regulation 2004

Hon Andrew WONG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the Electoral Affairs Commission (Electoral Procedure) (Legislative Council) (Amendment) Regulation 2004, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 84 of 2004 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 19 May 2004, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 7 July 2004.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

2. Food and Drugs (Composition and Labelling) (Amendment) Regulation 2004

Dr Hon LO Wing-lok moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the Food and Drugs (Composition and Labelling) (Amendment) Regulation 2004, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 85 of 2004 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 19 May 2004, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 7 July 2004.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Demonstrating the people's power on 1 July

Hon LEE Cheuk-yan moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council appeals to all the people of Hong Kong to demonstrate once again on 1 July this year the people's power and express Hong Kong people's determination to fight for universal suffrage, defend the core values of Hong Kong and improve the governance of the Government and people's livelihood.

While Hon LEE Cheuk-yan was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 5:57 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on the motion proposed.

Nine Members and Hon Michael MAK spoke on the motion.

At 7:03 pm, while Hon Michael MAK was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another nine Members and the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the motion.

Hon LEE Cheuk-yan replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon LEE Cheuk-yan claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 23 were present, six were in favour of the motion, 10 against it and seven abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 27 were present, 16 were in favour of the motion and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Enhancing the attractiveness of Hong Kong to tourists

Hon Howard YOUNG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, in view of the immense efforts of Hong Kong's neighbouring territories in enhancing the attractiveness of their tourist facilities and the opening of Hong Kong Disneyland next year, this Council urges the Government to step up its external publicity in promoting Hong Kong as an international tourist centre, and to comprehensively review, enhance and strengthen the attractiveness and competitiveness of various ancillary tourist facilities so as to cater for the increasing demands of tourists, and to devote all its effort

to attract more tourists with high spending power to visit Hong Kong.

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon CHAN Kam-lam would move an amendment to the motion and that Hon Miriam LAU would also move an amendment to Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion, the amendment, and the amendment to the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon CHAN Kam-lam moved the following amendment to Hon Howard YOUNG's motion and addressed the Council:

To add "; at the same time, this Council urges the Hong Kong Government to accelerate its communication with other governments in the Pan-Pearl River Delta ('PPRD') Region to materialize, as early as possible, the co-operation and development in tourism within the PPRD Region and synergize the complementary advantages of the various regions" after "demands of tourists".

Question on Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment to Hon Howard YOUNG's motion proposed.

Hon Miriam LAU moved the following amendment to Hon CHAN Kamlam's amendment and addressed the Council:

To add ", including perfecting the transport infrastructure, improving boundary-crossing facilities and alleviating the congestion problem at the boundary," after "within the PPRD Region"; and to add "reinforce Hong Kong's position as a 'cosmopolitan tourist centre' and" after "various regions, and to".

Question on Hon Miriam LAU's amendment to Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment proposed.

Five Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Henry WU spoke on the motion and the amendments and declared his interest as the director of The Ocean Park Corporation.

One more Member spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Howard YOUNG spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Question on Hon Miriam LAU's amendment to Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment put and agreed to.

Question on Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment as amended by Hon Miriam LAU to Hon Howard YOUNG's motion put and agreed to.

Hon Howard YOUNG replied.

Question on Hon Howard YOUNG's motion as amended by Hon CHAN Kam-lam and Hon Miriam LAU put and agreed to.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 16 June 2004 at 2:30 pm.

The Council was adjourned at 10:01 pm.
