A Member asked a supplementary and the Secretary for Economic Development and Labour replied.

After declaring her interest, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW asked a supplementary and the Secretary for Economic Development and Labour replied.

Another four Members asked supplementaries and the Secretary for Economic Development and Labour replied.

5. Ir Dr Hon HO Chung-tai asked Question 5.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour replied.

Seven Members asked supplementaries and the Secretary for Economic Development and Labour replied.

6. Hon WONG Sing-chi asked Question 6.

The Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands replied.

Three Members asked supplementaries and the Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands replied.

Written replies to Questions 7 to 20 were tabled for Members' information.

<u>Bills</u>

First Reading

Supplementary Appropriation (2003-2004) Bill

The Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

Second Reading

Supplementary Appropriation (2003-2004) Bill

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Inland Revenue (Amendment) Bill 2000

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 18 October 2000 resumed.

Dr Hon Eric LI, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Inland Revenue (Amendment) Bill 2000, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, he spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

Four more Members spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Inland Revenue (Amendment) Bill 2000.

Question that clauses 1, 3, 8, 10, 11, 12, 16, 18 to 22 and 24 to 27 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 2, 9, 13, 14, 15 and 17 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 2, 9, 13, 14, 15 and 17, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clause 4 stand part of the Bill proposed.

Council resumed by order of the Chairman. The President then granted leave for the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury to move a motion under Rule 91 of the Rules of Procedure that Rule 58(5) of the Rules of Procedure be suspended to enable the Committee of the whole Council to consider new clause 20A ahead of remaining clauses as it was related to clause 4.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council went into Committee again.

New clause 20A read the first time.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the Second Reading of new clause 20A and addressed the Committee. Question on the Second Reading of new clause 20A proposed, put and agreed to.

New clause 20A read the second time.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the addition of new clause 20A to the Bill and the amendments to clause 4 and addressed the Committee.

Question on the addition of new clause 20A to the Bill and the amendments to clause 4 proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clause 4, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 5 and 7 stand part of the Bill proposed.

One Member and the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury spoke on the motion.

Question that clauses 5 and 7 stand part of the Bill put.

Dr Hon Eric LI claimed a division. The Chairman then ordered the Committee to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The Chairman announced that 51 Members were present, 41 were in favour of the motion, eight against it and one abstained. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Hon Miriam LAU rose to move the following motion without notice:

That in the event of further divisions in relation to the remaining clauses or amendments thereto on Inland Revenue (Amendment) Bill 2000, the Council do proceed to each of such divisions after the division bell has been rung for one minute.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 6 and 23 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved amendments to the aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Three Members spoke on the amendments.

A Member, who had spoken, spoke again.

Question on the amendments put.

Dr Hon Eric LI claimed a division. The Chairman then ordered the Committee to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The Chairman announced that 51 Members were present, 32 were in favour of the amendment and 18 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the amendment was agreed.

Question that clauses 6 and 23, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

New clause 16A read the first time.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the Second Reading of new clause 16A and addressed the Committee.

Question on the Second Reading of new clause 16A proposed, put and agreed to.

New clause 16A read the second time.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the addition of new clause 16A to the Bill.

Question on the addition proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury reported that

the Inland Revenue (Amendment) Bill 2000

had passed through the Committee with amendments. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed and put

Dr Hon Eric LI claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 49 Members were present, 31 were in favour of the motion, eight against it and nine abstained. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried. Bill read the third time and passed.

<u>Motions</u>

Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour moved the motion in Appendix IV and addressed the Council.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Proposed resolution under the Public Finance Ordinance

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved, with respect to the Land Fund established by resolution made and passed by the Provisional Legislative Council on 23 July 1997 and published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 398 of 1997, that a sum of \$40,000,000,000 be transferred from the Land Fund to the general revenue.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Proposed resolution under the Airport Authority Ordinance

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that -

- (a) the authorized share capital of the Airport Authority referred to in section 23(1) of the Airport Authority Ordinance (Cap. 483) be reduced by an amount of \$6,000 million to \$30,648 million;
- (b) the Airport Authority shall distribute to the Government in cash an amount of \$6,000 million, such amount in the hands of the Government to be credited to the Capital Investment Fund established by resolution made and passed by the Legislative Council on 14 March 1990 under section 29 of the Public Finance Ordinance (Cap. 2); and
- (c) with effect from the date of receipt by the Government of the distribution referred to in paragraph (b), shares previously issued at par by the Airport Authority in accordance with section 23(3)(a) of the Airport Authority Ordinance (Cap. 483) and representing at the time of such issue a value of \$6,000 million in total be cancelled.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Members' Motions

Review of land policy

Hon Abraham SHEK moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as land is a precious asset possessed by all people of Hong Kong and is also an important source of revenue for the Government, and given that the West Kowloon Cultural District development project involves substantial subsidy in the form of 40 hectares of land (as large as 50 standard soccer pitches), this Council urges the Administration to critically review its policy, which is a remnant of the colonial era, of subsidizing commercially operated infrastructural projects in the form of land, based on the principle that, apart from ensuring an adequate supply of land for public housing development, the supply of land should be determined by the market according to demands and prices, in order that the Government can, through fair market competition, gain the maximum financial benefits, avoid disorderly development and loss of public funds, safequard public interest the and maintain market stability.

While Hon Abraham SHEK was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 6:20 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon Abraham SHEK's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon IP Kwok-him and Hon WONG Sing-chi would move amendments to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the two amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon IP Kwok-him and Hon WONG Sing-chi spoke respectively on the motion and their amendments.

Four Members and Hon Albert HO spoke on the motion and the amendments.

At 7:19 pm, while Hon Albert HO was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

While Hon Albert HO was still speaking, a man in the Public Gallery yelled noisily and continuously. The President ordered that the man be removed. Security staff escorted him away from the Chamber accordingly.

Hon Albert HO continued to speak on the motion and the amendments.

Another four Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Abraham SHEK spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon IP Kwok-him moved the following amendment to Hon Abraham SHEK's motion:

To add "and other developments compatible with the public interest" after "public housing development".

Question on Hon IP Kwok-him's amendment to Hon Abraham SHEK's motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Hon WONG Sing-chi moved the following further amendment to Hon Abraham SHEK's motion as amended by Hon IP Kwok-him:

To add "and commercially operated infrastructural projects, including those involving land grants to public corporations such as the Kowloon-Canton Railway Corporation, MTR Corporation Limited and Airport Authority, should be subject to the approval of the Legislative Council," after "demands and prices,"; to add "open and" after "through"; to delete "and" after "avoid disorderly development" and substitute with ","; and to add "as well as disposal of land at low prices" after "the loss of public funds".

Question on Hon WONG Sing-chi's amendment to Hon Abraham SHEK's motion as amended by Hon IP Kwok-him proposed and put.

Hon WONG Sing-chi claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 20 were present, four were in favour of the amendment, 15 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections and by the Election Committee, 19 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix V.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Question on Hon Abraham SHEK's motion as amended by Hon IP Kwok-him put and agreed to.

Promoting Hong Kong as a world-class financial services and asset management centre

Hon Ambrose LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, to achieve the goal mentioned by the Chief Executive in this year's Policy Address to develop Hong Kong into an international financial services and asset management centre such as Switzerland, this Council urges the Government to expeditiously and widely consult the views of the industry and other sectors, and to implement a series of measures to strengthen the competitive edge of Hong Kong's financial industry, including enhancing manpower training, improving the English standard of Hong Kong people, upgrading the financial infrastructure, as well as studying the provision of more tax concessions, so as to provide the entire Asia with high valueadded services in fund management, corporate investment management, personal banking, insurance sales and various investment and savings instruments.

Question on the motion proposed.

Six Members and the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury spoke on the motion.

Hon Ambrose LAU replied.

Question on the motion put and agreed to.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 23 June 2004 at 2:30 pm.

The Council was adjourned at 9:23 pm.
