### I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman for the 2003-2004 session

### **Election of Chairman**

Mr LAU Kong-wah called for nominations for the chairmanship of the

Panel for the 2003-2004 session.

- 2. Mr James TO was nominated by Mr Michael MAK and the nomination was seconded by Mr WONG Yung-kan. Mr James TO accepted the nomination.
- 3. There being no other nomination, <u>Mr LAU Kong-wah</u> declared Mr James TO elected as Chairman of the Panel. Mr James TO then took the chair.

## **Election of Deputy Chairman**

- 4. The Chairman called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel for the 2003-2004 session.
- 5. Mr WONG Yung-kan was nominated by Mr LAU Kong-wah and the nomination was seconded by Mr Michael MAK. Mr WONG Yung-kan accepted the nomination. There being no other nomination, the Chairman declared Mr WONG Yung-kan elected as Deputy Chairman of the Panel.

# II. Schedule of meetings for the 2003-2004 session

- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed that future regular meetings of the Panel would be held on the second Thursday of each month at 2:30 pm.
- 7. <u>Members</u> agreed that the regular meeting for April 2004 would be rescheduled from 8 April to 1 April 2004 at 2:30 pm because 8 April 2004 was too close to the Easter holiday.

## III. Items for discussion at the next meeting

- 8. <u>Members</u> agreed that a joint meeting with the Panel on Administration of Justice and Legal Services would be held on 27 October 2003 from 4:30 pm to 5:30 pm to discuss juvenile court system and proceedings.
- 9. <u>Members</u> also agreed that the next regular meeting would be held on Thursday, 13 November 2003 at 2:30 pm to discuss the following items -
  - (a) Criminal Procedure (Amendment) Bill concerning the determination of minimum terms in respect of prisoners detained at Executive Discretion;
  - (b) Application for Hong Kong permanent resident status by non-Chinese nationals; and
  - (c) Measures to combat illegal employment.

#### Action

- 10. Regarding the item referred to in paragraph 9(c) above, <u>members</u> agreed that the Administration should be requested to provide detailed statistical breakdown on Mainland residents illegally staying and/or working in Hong Kong.
