Our intention is to evaluate the occupancy situation and assess the cost implications after actual implementation of the Tool.</p> <p>(c) As the assessment tool is to identify the needy cases, we anticipate that the waiting list could be shortened. Based on a survey conducted in 2002 and the records of declining offers in our referral systems in the past 3 years, about 25 to 30% of the applications were premature applications which at the end would self-withdraw when a placement is offered. That having said, we could offer no concrete figures on the outcome</p>

			<p>of the waiting time though common-sense thinking is that with a shortening of the waiting list, the waiting time would be reduced.</p> <p>(d) The Assessment Tool is designed in a format that the assessment would take about an hour to complete. Factors such as familiarity on the persons to be assessed and the need to obtain other sources of information would affect the time of individual assessment. Pilot study is to be conducted to test on the practicability of the tool and find out other empirical data such as the time span required for the assessment.</p>

**Legislative Council Panel on Welfare Services
Meeting on 8 December 2003**

With regard to the discussion on the prevention measures against Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome among elders at the meeting of the LegCo Panel on Welfare Services held on 8 December 2003, we would like to provide Panel Members with the following supplementary information as requested:

(a) Providing influenza vaccination to elders at a concessionary rate

With effect from November 2003, General Out Patient Clinics of the Hospital Authority and Elderly Health Centres of the Department of Health have been providing free influenza vaccination to eligible non-institutionalised elders. In addition, service units of NGOs, such as district elderly community centres, neighbourhood elderly centres and social centres for the elderly, have provided needy elders

in the community with influenza vaccination at a concessionary rate from September to December 2003. As at end of December 2003, 173 centres/ service units have participated in the campaign, providing vaccination to most of the needy elders in the community. If there are further number of elders in need of vaccination in the local community, centres/ service units will refer them to relevant organisations, clinics or bodies providing medical services. Geographical distribution of the 173 service centres/ units by districts is at **Annex**.

(b) Provision of cleansing and maintenance services for needy elders upon the completion of the “Operation CARE” project

The Social Welfare Department (SWD) launched a 3-month “Operation CARE” project on 31 May and 16 June 2003, providing elders and individuals in need with household cleansing and minor repairs services respectively. Over 153 000 and 70 000 households have received household cleansing services and repairs services respectively.

A major achievement of the Operation CARE is the successful identification of elders in need of household cleansing and repairs services for referral to existing services, so that they may continue to receive the services. In fact, various organisations have been providing cleansing and repairs services for elders through existing community support services. For example:

- (i) volunteers from 40 support teams for the elderly have been providing services such as basic household cleansing and health education to elders on a territory-wide basis;
- (ii) 61 integrated home care services (IHCS) / home help teams and 18 enhanced home and community care services teams have been providing on-site services for elders on a territory-wide basis, including household cleansing; and
- (iii) NGOs have been providing household repairs services for individuals in need.

Through the Operation CARE, support teams for the elderly have approached around 16 000 elders and will include them into their support network. The needs of these elders will be identified, and

services will be arranged as appropriate. In addition, some elders have been referred to district elderly community centres, integrated home care services teams and home help teams for local support services.

To sustain the momentum of Operation CARE, SWD's 13 District Social Welfare Offices will continue to co-ordinate these services, such as liaising with relevant service units, district elderly community centres, IHCS teams, and volunteer organisations of NGOs to provide cleansing or household repairs services. Besides, uniform groups and various community organisations such as rural committees, schools, religious organisations, and mutual aid committees will render assistance as appropriate.
