NURSES (REGISTRATION AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2004

(Made by the Nursing Council of Hong Kong under section 27(3) of the Nurses Registration Ordinance (Cap. 164) with the approval of the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food)

1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 1 April 2004.

2. General provisions as to examinations

Regulation 13(3) of the Nurses (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulations (Cap. 164 sub. leg. A) is repealed.

Explanatory Note

This Regulation repeals regulation 13(3) of the Nurses (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulations (Cap. 164 sub. leg. A). Under that regulation, an applicant for registration as a nurse who has failed a required examination on two occasions shall not be entitled to re-enter for that examination unless he has undergone additional training at an approved training school for a period of not less than 6 months.
