**NURSES (REGISTRATION AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2004**

(Made by the Nursing Council of Hong Kong under section 27(3)  
of the Nurses Registration Ordinance (Cap. 164) with the  
approval of the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food)

**1. Commencement**

This Regulation shall come into operation on 1 April 2004.

**2. General provisions as to examinations**

Regulation 13(3) of the Nurses (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulations (Cap. 164 sub. leg. A) is repealed.

**Explanatory Note**

This Regulation repeals regulation 13(3) of the Nurses (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulations (Cap. 164 sub. leg. A). Under that regulation, an applicant for registration as a nurse who has failed a required examination on two occasions shall not be entitled to re-enter for that examination unless he has undergone additional training at an approved training school for a period of not less than 6 months.
