

**L.N. 90 of 2004****RADIOGRAPHERS (REGISTRATION AND DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2004**

(Made by the Supplementary Medical Professions Council under section 29(1B) of the Supplementary Medical Professions Ordinance (Cap. 359) subject to the approval of the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food)

**1. Commencement**

This Regulation shall come into operation on 1 August 2004.

**2. Interpretation (Part IV)**

Section 32 of the Radiographers (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation (Cap. 359 sub. leg. H) is amended, in the definition of “Secretary”, by adding “a counsel, a solicitor or” after “includes”.

**3. Appointment of counsel, solicitor or legal officer as Secretary**

Section 34 is amended—

- (a) by adding “of the Board appointed under section 5(4)(a) of the Ordinance” after “Secretary” where it first appears;
- (b) by adding “a counsel, a solicitor or” after “appoint”.

**4. Forms**

Schedule 2 is amended, in Forms 2A and 2B, by repealing “(ID No.: )”.

**5. Restrictions on practice of radiographers**

Part 1 of Schedule 4 is amended—

- (a) in item 3, in column 4, in paragraph (c), by repealing “spine” and substituting “vertebral column and peripheral joints, including the pelvis”;
- (b) in item 4, in column 4, in paragraph (a)(iii), by repealing “spine” and substituting “vertebral column and peripheral joints, including the pelvis”;

- (c) in item 5, in column 4, in paragraph (a)(iii), by repealing “spine, either,” and substituting “vertebral column and peripheral joints, including the pelvis, either”.

### **Explanatory Note**

This Regulation amends the Radiographers (Registration and Disciplinary Procedure) Regulation (Cap. 359 sub. leg. H)—

- (a) to change the definition of “Secretary” in Part IV to include a counsel and a solicitor;
- (b) to empower the Secretary for Justice to appoint a counsel or a solicitor to carry out the duties which a secretary has to perform in an inquiry;
- (c) to remove the requirement to provide identity card number in Forms 2A and 2B in Schedule 2; and
- (d) to clarify that diagnostic radiographers can accept referral by chiropractors for plain radiograph for the vertebral column and peripheral joints (including the pelvis).
