# DECLARATION OF CHANGE OF TITLES (CIVIL ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, TERRITORY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, DIRECTOR OF CIVIL ENGINEERING AND DIRECTOR OF TERRITORY DEVELOPMENT) NOTICE 2004

# 1. Commencement

This Notice shall come into operation on 1 July 2004.

# 2. Change of titles

- (1) The titles of—
  - (a) the Civil Engineering Department; and
- (b) the Territory Development Department, are declared to be changed to the Civil Engineering and Development Department.
  - (2) The titles of—
    - (a) the Director of Civil Engineering; and
- (b) the Director of Territory Development, are declared to be changed to the Director of Civil Engineering and Development.

## 3. Amendment of references to titles

- (1) The enactments specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 are amended in the provisions specified opposite thereto in column 3 of that Schedule by substituting "Civil Engineering and Development Department" for the titles specified opposite thereto in column 4 of that Schedule.
- (2) The enactments specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 are amended in the provisions specified opposite thereto in column 3 of that Schedule by substituting "Director of Civil Engineering and Development" for "Director of Civil Engineering".

# 4. Substitution of titles in other instruments, contracts or legal proceedings

The titles specified in column 3 of Schedule 3 are substituted for those specified opposite thereto in column 2 of that Schedule wherever occurring in any instruments, contracts or legal proceedings made or commenced before 1 July 2004.
