**PUBLIC HEALTH AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES ORDINANCE
(PUBLIC MARKETS) (DESIGNATION AND AMENDMENT
OF TENTH SCHEDULE) ORDER 2003**

(Made under section 79(3) and (5) of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

1. Cessation of designation as public market

The Central Market shall cease to be designated as a public market.

2. Public markets

The Tenth Schedule to the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) is amended by repealing—
“Central Market 中環街市”.

Explanatory Note
