**PUBLIC HEALTH AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES  
ORDINANCE (PUBLIC PLEASURE GROUNDS)  
(AMENDMENT OF FOURTH SCHEDULE)  
(NO. 4) ORDER 2003**

(Made under section 106(1) and (6) of the Public Health and  
Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

**1. Places set aside for use as public  
pleasure grounds**

The Hang Hong Street Garden and the San Hing Tsuen Children's Playground are set aside for use as public pleasure grounds.

**2. Place ceasing to be set aside for use as a  
public pleasure ground**

The Stanley Playground ceases to be set aside for use as a public pleasure ground.

**3. Public pleasure grounds**

The Fourth Schedule to the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) is amended, in the list of public pleasure grounds (other than bathing beaches)—

- (a) under the heading "The New Territories", by adding—  
"Hang Hong Street Garden  
San Hing Tsuen Children's Playground";
- (b) under the heading "The Island of Hong Kong", by repealing  
"Stanley Playground".

### **Explanatory Note**
