## List of follow-up actions arising from discussion at the meeting on 31 May 2005

The Administration was requested to –

- (a) provide a paper to explain the contemplated meeting arrangement for the Construction Industry Council (CIC). As the Administration proposes to extend the same administrative arrangements currently implemented by the Construction Industry Training Authority (CITA) to CIC, the Administration was requested to provide the details of the administrative arrangements including the guidelines promulgated by CITA in this respect and the percentage of agenda items the discussion on which was open to the pubic in the past three years;
- (b) provide a paper to set out the financial position of CITA. The paper should include the following information:
  - (i) a breakdown of the annual income of CITA over the past three years;
  - (ii) a breakdown of the annual expenditure of CITA over the past three years;
  - (iii) a breakdown of the projected annual income of CITA in the coming two to three years; and
  - (iv) a breakdown of the estimated annual expenditure of CITA in the coming two to three years; and
- (c) provide a complete set of Committee Stage Amendments to facilitate clause-by-clause examination.
