

Bills Committee on Construction Industry Council (No. 2) Bill

**List of follow-up actions arising from discussion
at the meeting on 10 October 2005**

The Administration is requested to –

Clause 1

- (a) advise in writing the timeframe contemplated by the Administration with respect to the establishment of the Construction Industry Council (CIC) and the dissolution of the Construction Industry Training Authority;

Clause 2

- (b) review the definition of “construction operations” to address operational difficulty, if any, encountered in collecting levy;
- (c) advise the channels/mechanism to ensure construction operations which are subject to levy are traceable and that the contractors concerned are made aware of the liability for payment of the levy;
- (d) review the Chinese rendition of “Objections Committee”. One suggested version is “處理反對事宜委員會”;

Clause 5

- (e) review the drafting of clause 5(j). A member is concerned how CIC could **monitor** improvements made by the construction industry through compilation of performance indicators; and
- (f) consider the strategic framework governing the relationship between the Environment, Transport and Works Bureau and CIC.
