2. The Bills Committee completed scrutiny of the Bill and the proposed Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) clause-by-clause. The Administration was requested to provide a set of updated CSAs taking into account comments of the Bills Committee. The Bills Committee instructed Assistant Legal Adviser 1 to liaise with the Administration on the drafting of the finalised version of CSAs and assist in vetting the Chinese version.

3. The Bills Committee expressed support for the Bill to resume its Second Reading debate at the Council meeting on 2 November 2005. <u>The Chairman</u> informed members that the Bills Committee would report to the House Committee on 21 October 2005. <u>The Chairman</u> also reminded members that the deadline for giving notice of CSAs was 24 October 2005.
