2. The Administration was requested to provide a response in writing to the following suggestions made by members at the meeting -

- (a) to empower manager of a school or specified educational establishment to exempt smoking act in a live performance held in a venue for live performance in that school or specified educational establishment; and
- (b) to delete “席” from the Chinese version of the definition of “live performance” in new clause 22A.

3. The Administration undertook to -
 - (a) ensure whether tobacco companies could not make use of the provisions under new clause 22A to display a tobacco brand name and/or logo; and
 - (b) find out from the Liquor Licensing Board about the issuance of a separate licence to a bar located in premises already holding a liquor licence in order to enable that bar to become a qualified bar provided under the Bill.
