I. Meeting with the Administration

- 2. The Administration was requested to re-consider -
 - (a) making employees' shared accommodation and any public pleasure ground listed in the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) smokefree; and
 - (b) prohibiting the sale of any tobacco product to people in school uniform.
- 3. The Administration undertook to -
 - (a) check with the Leisure and Cultural Services Department on which areas of the stadium and public swimming pool specified in Cap. 132

would be designated as no smoking areas; and

- (b) provide a full set of the latest Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) to be moved by the Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food before the meeting on 16 June 2006.
- 4. <u>The Administration</u> informed the Bills Committee that after considering members' views expressed at the meeting on 19 May 2006 regarding the display of no smoking signs, it still proposed to repeal the requirement for managers of statutory no smoking areas to display no smoking signs under section 5 of the Smoking (Public Health) Ordinance.
- 5. <u>Members</u> agreed that the Bills Committee would submit a report for the House Committee (HC) meeting on 23 June 2006 recommending resumption of Second Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting on 12 July 2006.
- 6. <u>Members</u> further agreed to decide at the next meeting which CSAs proposed by members should be taken over by the Bills Committee.
