2. The Administration was requested to provide in writing the criteria for designating smoking areas in public pleasure grounds.
3. The Administration undertook to introduce Committee Stage amendments (CSAs) to make clear that bars or mahjong rooms in recreation clubs set up by disciplinary forces and/or other Government departments would not be allowed to become a qualified establishment under new Schedule 6.
4. The Administration agreed to strive to advise members on 27 September 2006 as far as possible about its stance of revising the CSAs to clause 11 to impose a general ban on the use of misleading words on the packaging of tobacco products.
