## List of follow-up actions to be taken by the Administration

- 1. The Administration is requested to provide information on -
  - (a) the actual profit or loss of Tate's Cairn Tunnel Company Limited in the year 2004-05 and the base case projection for that year; and
  - (b) the actual traffic throughput of Tate's Cairn Tunnel in the year 2004-05 and the base case forecast for that year in the franchise bid.
- 2. Given that public interests are involved in the toll increase of Tai Lam Tunnel, members of the Subcommittee consider that information on Route 3 (CPS) Company Limited (the Company)'s net revenue and financial position should not be kept confidential and should be made known to the public. In this connection, the Administration is requested to provide the justifications and legal basis on which it comes to the view that it could not disclose such information to the public.
- 3. The Administration is requested to advise whether, and if so, how, Schedule 4 to the Tai Lam Tunnel and Yuen Long Approach Road Ordinance (Cap. 474) could be amended; and the implications, if any, of such amendments.
