1. Heritage Tourism Development Project at the Central Police Station Compound	25.10.2004	The Administration was requested to (a) review the classification of historic buildings and include more buildings under Type A category; and (b) consider preserving the F Hall of the Victoria Prison	The Administration had conveyed Members' views to the Antiquities Advisory Board (the "AAB") for consideration. After deliberation, the AAB decided to make no change to the conservation approach of F Hall under the existing classification system of buildings into three types, namely (a) Type A Historic Building; (b) Type B Historic Building; and (c) non-historic building. Having regard to its relatively short history, substantial alterations and its incompatible architectural style to the surrounding buildings, the F Hall should retain its present conservation approach as a non-historic building which does not require the building to be preserved in-situ.
