- ***A shared facility at Convention Centre = best use of resources***
- ***Central Business District location maximises connectivity***
- ***Minimal noise impact – well out in harbour – no residential***

OUR PROPOSAL IS A VIBRANT, LIVELY AND WORLD CLASS FACILITY

- ***This would be the view of the converted pier from Golden Bauhinia Square***
- ***Preserves existing building – this is a natural noise barrier***
- ***Allows for possibility of restaurants, shops, museum, observation deck***
- ***Accessible to all and enhances a potential vibrant harbourfront***
- ***Incorporates a secure GFS facility***

A SHARED MINIMALIST FACILITY CLEARLY A SECOND CHOICE

- Unsightly noise barrier***
- No room for landscaping***
- No community amenities***
