- (4) Based on operational logistics and needs, individual cluster / hospital may only stock part of the drugs listed in the HA Standard Drug Formulary. Patient will be provided with the appropriate drug (preparation) within a class of drug listed in the HA Standard Drug Formulary.
- (5) The Specialty Panels and Drug Utilisation Review Committee of the Hospital Authority will review and may revise this draft HA Standard Drug Formulary based on the feedback from relevant parties during the internal and external consultation period.
