I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

Dr LUI Ming-wah, member of the Panel who had the highest precedence among the members present, presided over the election of the Chairman of the Panel.

2. Members noted that Ms Emily LAU had informed the Panel in writing of her withdrawal of membership from the Panel.

3. Dr LUI Ming-wah invited nominations for the chairmanship. Mr SIN Chung-kai was nominated by Mr Albert Jinghan CHENG and the nomination was seconded by Mr Howard YOUNG and Mr Jasper TSANG. Mr SIN accepted the nomination.

4. There being no other nomination, Mr SIN Chung-kai was elected Chairman of the Panel for the 2004-2005 session. Mr SIN then took over the chair and called for nominations for the deputy chairmanship. Mr Albert Jinghan CHENG was nominated by Mr Howard YOUNG and seconded by Mr Jasper TSANG. Mr CHENG accepted the nomination.

5. There being no other nomination, the Chairman declared that Mr Albert Jinghan CHENG was elected Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2004-2005 session.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2004-2005 session

6. Members agreed that the regular monthly meetings of the Panel for the 2004-2005 session would be held on the second Monday of each month at 2:30 pm except for April 2005 which would clash with the Special Finance Committee meetings from 11 to 14 April 2005. Members agreed to reschedule the April meeting at a later time.

7. Members noted that the Administration had proposed to discuss the following agenda items at the next Panel meeting to be held on 8 November 2004:

- (a) Regulation of Internet Protocol (IP) Telephony; and
- (b) Funding requirement for Capital Works Reserve Fund Head 710 Computerization Subhead A007GX (Block Allocation) in 2005-06.

8. On 7(a), members noted that the period of the relevant consultation exercise would end on 4 December 2004. The Chairman advised that should the Panel wish to invite the views and attendance of deputations, the meeting for such purpose should preferably be fixed near the end of the consultation period. He suggested that the Panel could first invite the Administration to brief members on the details of the consultation on 8 November 2004 and then receive the views of deputations at the December meeting. Members agreed in principle to his suggestion. They also agreed that the Chairman would finalize the agenda for the November meeting in conjunction with the Clerk and the Administration.
