## Panel on Security

At the meeting of the Security Panel held on 13 June 2005 when Members discussed the paper on "Integration and Application of Information Technology in the New Headquarters Building of the Independent Commission Against Corruption", questions were asked whether the computer system for ICAC telecommunication interception work was included in the above IT development plan.

Under the IT strategic development plan for the ICAC, neither the first phase (i.e. two projects on the construction of a new IT infrastructure and systems migration, and the implementation of applications to improve ICAC's corporate information and resource management) for which funding approval will be sought from the Finance Committee on 24 June, nor the second phase for which funding application will be submitted after completion of the feasibility studies in 2008 covers any telecommunication interception work. On grounds of public interest, the ICAC will not disclose any information on telecommunication interception work.
