Panel on Security List of follow-up actions required of the Administration

I refer to your letter dated 9 January 2006, asking us to provide the information referred to in items 4(b) and 9 of the list.

On item 4(b) on "Powers of the ICAC to search for and seize journalistic material", the case has been set down for trial for 25 days at the District Court commencing 20 February 2006. We consider it appropriate to provide the required information after the legal proceedings have concluded.

On item 9 on "Corruption prevention work of the ICAC", our response is as follows –

"The Corruption Prevention Department of the Independent Commission Against Corruption will proactively approach Bureaux and Departments which are in the process of planning Public Private Partnership (PPP) projects, with a view to providing early corruption prevention advice. Specifically, we will assist in the formulation of fair and corruption resistant procedures for selecting the PPP partner, with emphasis on an effective mechanism for managing conflict of interest."
