

L.N. 209 of 2004**TELECOMMUNICATIONS (METHOD FOR DETERMINING SPECTRUM UTILIZATION FEES) (THIRD GENERATION MOBILE SERVICES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATION 2004**

(Made under section 32I of the Telecommunications Ordinance (Cap. 106))

1. Commencement

This Regulation shall come into operation on 3 February 2005.

2. Application

Section 3 of the Telecommunications (Method for Determining Spectrum Utilization Fees) (Third Generation Mobile Services) Regulation (Cap. 106 sub. leg. X) is amended by repealing “4 sets of frequency bands designated in” and substituting “frequency bands set out in Part 1 of the Schedule to”.

Explanatory Note

The Telecommunications (Designation of Frequency Bands subject to Payment of Spectrum Utilization Fee) (Amendment) Order 2004 (L.N. 208 of 2004) (“the Amendment Order”) designates additional sets of frequency bands in which the use of spectrum is subject to the payment of spectrum utilization fee. This Regulation makes it clear that the Telecommunications (Method for Determining Spectrum Utilization Fees) (Third Generation Mobile Services) Regulation (Cap. 106 sub. leg. X) only applies to the 4 sets of frequency bands that have been designated before the making of the Amendment Order.
