Bills

Carriage by Air (Amendment) Bill 2005

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 22 June 2005 resumed.

After declaring his interests as an Executive Committee Member of the Board of Airline Representatives Hong Kong and an employee of the Cathay Pacific Airways, Hon Howard YOUNG spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the Carriage by Air (Amendment) Bill 2005.

Question that clauses 1 to 27 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour reported that

the Carriage by Air (Amendment) Bill 2005

had passed through the Committee without amendment. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Members' Motions

Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance

Hon Fred LI moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the Harmful Substances in Food (Amendment) Regulation 2005, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 137 of 2005 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 12 October 2005, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 30 November 2005.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance

Hon Miriam LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

Resolved that in relation to the Closed Area (Hong Kong Ministerial Conference of World Trade Organization) Order, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 160 of 2005 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 12 October

2005, the period for amending subsidiary legislation referred to in section 34(2) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) be extended under section 34(4) of that Ordinance to the meeting of 30 November 2005.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Minimum wage, standard working hours

Hon CHAN Yuen-han drew the attention of the President to the absence of a quorum. The President directed the Clerk to summon Members to the meeting. A quorum was then present.

Hon CHAN Yuen-han moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, as the working conditions of the grass-roots workers are worsening, their wages are low and their working hours are long, the low-income population is still increasing despite Hong Kong's substantial economic growth last year, and as some low-income families have to even rely on Comprehensive Social Security Assistance payment to eke out a living, this Council suggests that, to enable the grass-roots workers to share the fruits of economic growth which they deserve, the Government should encourage employers to increase the pay and improve the fringe benefits for their employees and, at the same time, urges the Government to expeditiously:

- (a) legislate for a minimum wage to safeguard the most basic living standard of the workers, with priority accorded to individual low-income industries and jobs, so that employers of private enterprises are required to take on the social responsibility they should shoulder, so as to prevent them from shifting their business operating costs to the Government and thereby increasing the expenditure on social welfare; and
- (b) regulate the number of working hours, reasonable rest breaks during working hours and overtime allowance, so as to ensure that employees have sufficient time for rest and studies.

While Hon CHAN Yuen-han was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 1:30 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon Andrew CHENG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate. Hon Andrew CHENG moved the following amendment to Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion and addressed the Council:

To delete "regulate" before "the number of working hours" and substitute with "enact law for regulating"; and to add "the basis for calculating" after "during working hours and".

Question on Hon Andrew CHENG's amendment to Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion proposed.

Eight Members and Hon TSANG Yok-sing spoke on the motion and the amendment.

At 2:40 pm, while Hon TSANG Yok-sing was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 21 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

With the President's permission, Hon Mrs Sophie LEUNG elucidated on a point she had made earlier and which had been misunderstood by Hon LEE Cheuk-yan.

Three more Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon CHAN Yuen-han spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Economic Development and Labour spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Andrew CHENG's amendment to Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion put.

Hon Andrew CHENG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment, 15 against it and three abstained; Members returned among the by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 28 were present, 19 were in favour of the amendment, two against it and six abstained. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon CHAN Yuen-han replied.

Question on Hon CHAN Yuen-han's motion put.

Dr Hon YEUNG Sum claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 26 were present, 11 were in favour of the motion and 15 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 28 were present, 25 were in favour of the motion and two against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Constitutional reform proposal

Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

this Council considers that the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region ("HKSAR") Government is responsible for putting forward a constitutional reform proposal that acceptable to Hong Kong citizens and which encompasses concrete democratization processes; such proposal should not confer upon the appointed District Council members the rights select the Chief Executive or elect Members of Legislative Council; furthermore, the HKSAR Government is also responsible for setting out in its proposal a roadmap and a timetable for achieving universal suffrage as well as the relevant details of the elections.

While Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 5:43 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on the motion proposed.

Two Members and Hon Martin LEE spoke on the motion.

At 6:15 pm, while Hon Martin LEE was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 11 Members and Hon TAM Heung-man spoke on the motion.

While Hon TAM Heung-man was speaking, the President left the chair at 7:27 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Three more Members and Hon LEE Wing-tat spoke on the motion.

At 7:55 pm, while Hon LEE Wing-tat was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Nine more Members and the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the motion.

Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 27 were present, seven were in favour of the motion, 19 against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 27 were present, 16 were in favour of the motion and 10 against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 16 November 2005 at 11:00 am.

The Council was adjourned at 9:33 pm.
