Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which had been moved on 27 April 2005 resumed.

Hon CHOY So-yuk, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Protection of Endangered Species of Animals and Plants Bill, addressed the Council on the Report of the Bills Committee on the Bill. After the address, she spoke on the Bill in her personal capacity as a Member.

Another Member spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

Proposed resolution under the Public Bus Services Ordinance

Members' Motions

Implementing the recommendations of the United Nations Human Rights Committee

Hon Emily LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, noting that the United Nations Human Rights Committee will hold a hearing on 20 March this year to consider the Second Report on the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China in the light of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights submitted last year, this Council urges the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to implement the recommendations that have been and will be made by the Committee.

While Hon Emily LAU was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 3:02 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon Emily LAU's motion proposed.

The President's Deputy stated that Hon Tommy CHEUNG would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Tommy CHEUNG moved the following amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion and addressed the Council:

To add ", having regard to the actual situation in Hong Kong" after "will be made by the Committee".

Question on Hon Tommy CHEUNG's amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion proposed.

Hon Albert HO spoke on the motion and the amendment. At 3:23 pm, while he was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another 16 Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Emily LAU spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Home Affairs and the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Martin LEE requested the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs to elucidate the meaning of a term in his speech. The President stated that Hon Martin LEE should have raised the request immediately after the Secretary for Constitutional Affairs had used the term, and not until he had finished his speech.

The Secretary for Security spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Tommy CHEUNG's amendment to Hon Emily LAU's motion put.

Hon SIN Chung-kai claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, 16 were in favour of the amendment, seven against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 27 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment and 18 against it. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Emily LAU replied.

Question on Hon Emily LAU's motion put.

Hon Emily LAU claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 24 were present, eight were in favour of the motion and 16 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 28 were present, 18 were in favour of the motion and nine against it. (Voting record in Appendix III.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Development planning for Lantau

Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, given the slow progress of work since the Government drew up the Concept Plan for Lantau in 2004, this Council urges the Government to expedite the planning study on Lantau and, provided that nature conservation and preservation of historical and cultural heritage are taken into consideration, to expeditiously put the following development directions into effect:

- (a) developing in the area theme tour routes which have historical and cultural value and ecological characteristics and which complement existing recreational facilities, so as to develop Lantau into a quality tourism area;
- (b) in line with the construction of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge and other infrastructural facilities, creating favourable conditions for developing new economic activities in the area; and
- (c) completing, as soon as possible, the feasibility study on the construction of a logistics park on Lantau.

Question on Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung, Dr Hon KWOK Kaki and Hon LEE Wing-tat would move amendments to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the three amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung and Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Hon LEE Wing-tat spoke on the motion and the amendments. While he was speaking, the President left the chair at 6:51 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Eight Members and Hon Daniel LAM Wai-keung spoke on the motion and the amendments.

At 7:49 pm, while Hon Daniel LAM Wai-keung was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another seven Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Housing, Planning and Lands spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung moved the following amendment to Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming's motion:

To delete ", given the slow progress of work since the Government drew up the Concept Plan for Lantau in 2004," after "That"; to delete "to expedite the planning study on Lantau and" after "this Council urges the Government" and substitute with ", in considering the development planning for Lantau, to put the following directions into effect"; to delete ", to expeditiously put the following development directions into effect" after "taken into consideration"; to delete "in line with the construction of" after "(b)" and substitute with "the

plans to construct"; to delete ", creating favourable conditions for developing new economic activities in the area; and" after "other infrastructural facilities" and substitute with "should be implemented only after they have gone through strict environmental impact assessments and secured extensive support from the local residents affected;"; and to add "; (d) expeditiously building a hospital on Lantau; and providing arts, recreational and sports facilities in Tung Chung; and (e) shelving the plan for further reclamation in Tung Chung; and restricting the number of high-rise buildings in the district, so as to alleviate the deteriorating air pollution problem there" after "logistics park on Lantau".

Question on Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung's amendment to Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming's motion proposed and put.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 17 were present, six were in favour of the amendment, nine against it and two abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 17 were present, six were in favour of the amendment, four against it and six abstained. (Voting record in Appendix IV.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU rose to move the following motion without notice:

That in the event of further divisions in relation to the motion or amendments thereto on "Development planning for Lantau", the Council do proceed to each of such divisions after the division bell has been rung for one minute.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki moved the following amendment to Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming motion:

To delete "slow progress of work" after "That, given the" and substitute with "diverse views and grave concern expressed by the public"; to add "and commenced public consultation" after "Concept Plan for Lantau"; to delete "expedite" after "this Council urges the Government to" and substitute with "allow public participation in"; to delete "provided that" after "the planning study on Lantau and," and substitute with "in line with the principles of minimum reclamation,"; to delete "are taken into consideration, to expeditiously" after "cultural heritage" and substitute with ", to"; to add "(a) expeditiously providing relevant community facilities

(including hospitals, sports complexes and libraries) on Lantau, having regard to the needs of the local residents, the size of population and the characteristics of the local community; (b) perfecting and enhancing the country parks on Lantau; " after "development directions into effect:"; to delete the original "(a)" and substitute with "(c)"; to delete "tourism area" after "develop Lantau into a quality" substitute with "eco-tourism area for the enjoyment of all Hong Kong people"; to delete the original "(b)" and substitute with "(d)"; to delete "in line with" before "the construction the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge" and substitute with "conducting environmental impact assessments regarding"; to "," after "other infrastructural facilities" and delete substitute with "; providing suitable complementary facilities to minimize the adverse impacts of the construction on the local environment; and"; to delete the original "(c)" substitute with "(e)"; and to delete "completing, as soon as possible," before "the feasibility study" and substitute with "including the conduct of an environmental impact assessment and extensive public consultation in".

Question on Dr Hon KWOK Ka-ki's amendment to Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming's motion proposed and put.

Dr Hon KWOK Kai-ki claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 17 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment and nine against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 17 were present, 12 were in favour of the amendment and four against it. (Voting record in Appendix V.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon LEE Wing-tat moved the following amendment to Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming motion:

To add ", give an account of the work progress" after "the planning study on Lantau"; to add "; and submitting a concrete proposal for implementing the original planning intention of retaining Lantau South as a conservation area" after "a quality tourism area"; to delete "feasibility study on" after "as soon as possible, the" and substitute with "environmental impact assessments, feasibility studies and demand assessments regarding"; to add "the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge and relevant road links as well as" before "a logistics park on Lantau" and to add ", and publishing the results of such assessments and studies" thereafter.

Question on Hon LEE Wing-tat's amendment to Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming's motion proposed and put.

Hon Tommy CHEUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 17 were present, eight were in favour of the amendment, two against it and seven abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 18 were present and 17 were in favour of the amendment. (Voting record in Appendix VI.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming replied.

Question on Hon CHEUNG Hok-ming's motion put.

Hon LEUNG Yiu-chung claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to divide under Rule 49(5) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 17 were present, 15 were in favour of the motion, one against it and one abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 17 were present, 12 were in favour of the motion and four against it. (Voting record in Appendix VII.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

PUBLIC FINANCE ORDINANCE

RESOLUTION

(Under section 7(1) of the Public Finance Ordinance (Cap. 2))

RESOLVED that -

- 1. Authority is hereby given for a sum not exceeding \$55,884,844,000 to be charged on the general revenue for expenditure on the services of the Government in respect of the financial year commencing on 1 April 2006.
- 2. Subject to this Resolution, the sum so charged may be expended against the heads of expenditure as shown in the Estimates of Expenditure 2006-07 laid before the Legislative Council on 22 February 2006 or, where the Estimates are changed under the provisions of the Public Finance Ordinance (Cap. 2) as applied by section 7(2) of that Ordinance, as shown in the Estimates as so changed.

 - (b) in the case of an Operating Account Non-Recurrent subhead of expenditure or Capital Account subhead of expenditure, an amount equivalent to 100% of the provision shown in the Estimates in respect of that subhead,

or such other amount, not exceeding an amount equivalent to 100% of the provision shown in the Estimates in respect of that subhead, as may in any case be approved by the Financial Secretary.
