RESOLVED that the District Councils Ordinance (Amendment of Schedule  
1) Order 2006, made by the Chief Executive in Council on 9 May  
2006, be approved.

## **DISTRICT COUNCILS ORDINANCE (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 1) ORDER 2006**

(Made by the Chief Executive in Council under section 8 of the District Councils Ordinance (Cap. 547) subject to the approval of the Legislative Council)

### **1. Commencement**

This Order shall –

- (a) come into operation on 14 July 2006 for the purpose only of enabling arrangements to be made for the holding of the District Council ordinary election in 2007; and
- (b) in so far as it has not come into operation under paragraph (a), come into operation on 1 January 2008.

### **2. Number of and declaration of Districts**

Part II of Schedule 1 to the District Councils Ordinance (Cap. 547) is amended –

- (a) in item 5, by repealing “DC/2000/F” and substituting “DC/2006/F”;
- (b) in item 11, by repealing “DC/2000/S” and substituting “DC/2006/S”.

### **Explanatory Note**

Each area declared to be a District for the purposes of the District Councils Ordinance (Cap. 547) and the number assigned to the map delineating each such area are set out in Part II of Schedule 1 to the Ordinance.

2. The effect of this Order is to realign the boundaries of Sham Shui Po District and Kwai Tsing District (by substituting new maps in place of existing maps that delineate the area of the 2 Districts) in order to put Nob Hill, which straddles the 2 Districts, wholly within Sham Shui Po District.
