**Antiquities and Monuments Ordinance (Cap. 53)  
Antiquities and Monuments (Declaration of Historical Building) Notice 2005  
(L.N. 236)**

By this Notice made by the Secretary for Home Affairs (“the Secretary”) under section 3(1) of the Antiquities and Monuments Ordinance (Cap. 53) (“the Ordinance”) after consultation with the Antiquities Advisory Board and with the approval of the Chief Executive, the building known as Cape D’ Aguilar Lighthouse at Cape D’ Aguilar, Hong Kong, and its adjoining land, is declared to be a historical building (“the Building”) for the purposes of the Ordinance. The effect of this Notice is that with effect from 3 March 2006, no person shall excavate in, demolish, deface or interfere with the Building except in accordance with a permit granted by the Secretary.

**Tax Reserve Certificates Ordinance (Cap. 289)  
Tax Reserve Certificates (Fourth Series) Rules (Cap. 289 sub. leg. A)  
Tax Reserve Certificates (Rate of Interest) (No. 10) Notice 2005 (L.N. 237)**

2. This Notice fixes the rate of interest payable on tax reserve certificates issued on or after 3 January 2006 at 2.8500% per annum.
