I. Meeting with the Administration

The Subcommittee deliberated (Index of proceedings at **Annex**).

2. The Subcommittee raised no further questions on the three papers provided by the Administration for discussion at the last meeting on 7 November 2005 (LC Paper Nos. CB(2)295/05-06(01) to (03)) and on the Closed Area (Hong Kong Ministerial Conference of World Trade Organization) Order (the Order).

II. Any other business

3. The Chairman concluded that the Subcommittee had completed scrutiny of the Order, and a report would be submitted to the House Committee on 18 November 2005.

Some members considered that an opportunity should be provided at a Council meeting for Members to express their views and concerns about the security and public order issues relating to the Sixth Ministerial Conference (MC6) of the World Trade Organization and for the Administration to respond to Members' views and concerns. In the light of this, the Subcommittee agreed on the following -

- (a) recommending to the House Committee that the Chairman of the Subcommittee should move a motion for adjournment under Rule 16(4) of the Rules of Procedure at the Council meeting on 23 November 2005, for the purpose of debating the security and public order issues relating to the MC6; and
- (b) seeking the House Committee's support for the President's leave to dispense with the seven days' requisite notice period for the motion.

5. The next meeting scheduled for 15 November 2005 at 8:30 am was cancelled.

6. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 10:55 am.
