### **RESOLUTION**

(Under section 13 of the Radiation Ordinance (Cap. 303))

---

RESOLVED that the following Regulations, made by the Radiation Board on 2 May 2006, be approved –

- (a) the Radiation (Control of Radioactive Substances) (Fee Revision) Regulation 2006; and
- (b) the Radiation (Control of Irradiating Apparatus) (Fee Reduction) Regulation 2006.

**RADIATION (CONTROL OF RADIOACTIVE SUBSTANCES)  
(FEE REVISION) REGULATION 2006**

(Made by the Radiation Board under section 13 of the Radiation Ordinance  
(Cap. 303) subject to the approval of the Legislative Council)

**1. Commencement**

This Regulation shall come into operation on 1 July 2006.

**2. Licence**

Regulation 4(1) of the Radiation (Control of Radioactive Substances) Regulations (Cap. 303 sub. leg. A) is amended by repealing “\$2,770” and substituting “\$3,190”.

**3. Radiation Board to keep records of medical examinations**

Regulation 16(2) is amended by repealing “\$95” and substituting “\$30”.

**Explanatory Note**

This Regulation amends the Radiation (Control of Radioactive Substances) Regulations (Cap. 303 sub. leg. A) (“the Regulations”) –

- (a) to reduce the fee payable for the issue of a certified copy of a certificate of medical examination under the Regulations; and

- (b) to increase the fee payable for the grant or renewal of a licence for radioactive substances under the Radiation Ordinance (Cap. 303).

**RADIATION (CONTROL OF IRRADIATING APPARATUS)  
(FEE REDUCTION) REGULATION 2006**

(Made by the Radiation Board under section 13 of the Radiation Ordinance  
(Cap. 303) subject to the approval of the Legislative Council)

**1. Commencement**

This Regulation shall come into operation on 1 July 2006.

**2. Board to keep records of medical examinations**

Regulation 11(2) of the Radiation (Control of Irradiating Apparatus) Regulations (Cap. 303 sub. leg. B) is amended by repealing “\$95” and substituting “\$30”.

**3. Fees**

Schedule 2 is amended –

- (a) in category 1, by repealing “585” and substituting “410”;
- (b) in category 3, by repealing “330” and substituting “160”.

### **Explanatory Note**

This Regulation amends the Radiation (Control of Irradiating Apparatus) Regulations (Cap. 303 sub. leg. B) (“the Regulations”) to reduce the fees payable under the Regulations for the issue of a certified copy of a certificate of medical examination, a licence to possess an irradiating apparatus in a non-functional state and a licence to use an irradiating apparatus.
