1.	November 2003	ICAC received complaints regarding Mr Michael Wong and commenced an investigation.
2.	21 September 2004	Mr Michael Wong provided statements to the Independent Panel of Inquiry on the Incidents relating to the Equal Opportunities Commission.
3.	17January 2005	Department of Justice (DoJ) received initial ICAC investigation report. [DoJ provided interim advices to the ICAC on 27 January 2005, 1 March 2005, 14 June 2005 and 11 August 2005.]
4.	24 February 2005	Lawyers acting for Mr Michael Wong made representations to the DoJ.
5.	15 November 2005	DoJ received finalized ICAC investigation report.
6.	Mid-November 2005	Mr Macleod, DDPP, submitted his opinion to the DPP.
7.	Late November 2005	Queen's Counsel in London was instructed to give an opinion to the DPP.
8.	14 December 2005	Opinion of Queen's Counsel received.
9.	Mid-December 2005	DPP considered the case and advised SJ of his decision.
10.	21 December 2005	DoJ provided ICAC with finalized advice.
11.	25 January 2006	ICAC Operations Review Committee Meeting held to discuss Mr Wong case (a.m.). DPP's statement on Mr Wong case released (p.m.).
