Proposed domestic heliport development	25.7.2005 (joint meeting with PLW Panel)	<p>The Administration was requested to provide the following information -</p> <p>(a) an assessment of the adequacy of the planned and existing facilities to meet future demand for cross-boundary helicopter services;</p> <p>(b) whether the Administration's plans in respect of infrastructure facilities for both domestic and cross-boundary helicopter services were concordant with Article 128 of the Basic Law; and</p> <p>(c) the environmental impact of the proposed Government helipad and the recommended mitigation measures.</p>	The subject matter was further discussed by the joint-Panel on 24 October 2005. The joint-Panel had not come up with a unanimous view on the matter. On item (c), the Administration indicated at the meeting that it would proceed to undertake the technical feasibility study for the proposed Government helipad.

Proposed funding arrangement for Ocean Park's redevelopment plans	28.11.2005	The Administration was requested to indicate its position on the proposed implementation of South Island Line (SIL) (East) in its funding proposal to be submitted to the Finance Committee (FC).	The Administration's position on the SIL has been indicated in the FC paper submitted for its consideration on 16 December 2005.
