District Open Space in Area 107 in Tin Shui Wai

In the meeting of the Legislative Council Panel on Home Affairs (HA Panel) held on 12 May 2006, Members supported the proposed project of the District Open Space in Area 107 in Tin Shui Wai to be put forward to the Public Works Subcommittee (PWSC) for consideration. In the course of discussion, you asked the Administration to provide a plan and timetable on providing football pitches in the remaining portion of Area 107 in Tin Shui Wai which was adjacent to the site of the project before the submission of the project to the PWSC.

The Administration needs to draw up a proposal and consult the Culture, Recreation and Sports Committee (CRSC) of Yuen Long District Council before providing the plan and timetable to members of the HA Panel.
