LegCo Information Technology and Broadcasting Panel arrives London to continue study tour

The delegation of the Legislative Council Panel on Information Technology and Broadcasting completed its visit to USA and departed Washington DC for London today (April 18) to continue its overseas study tour on public service broadcasting.

On its visit to Washington DC, the delegation visited two radio and television membership organizations in the production and distribution of public broadcasting programmes in USA.
