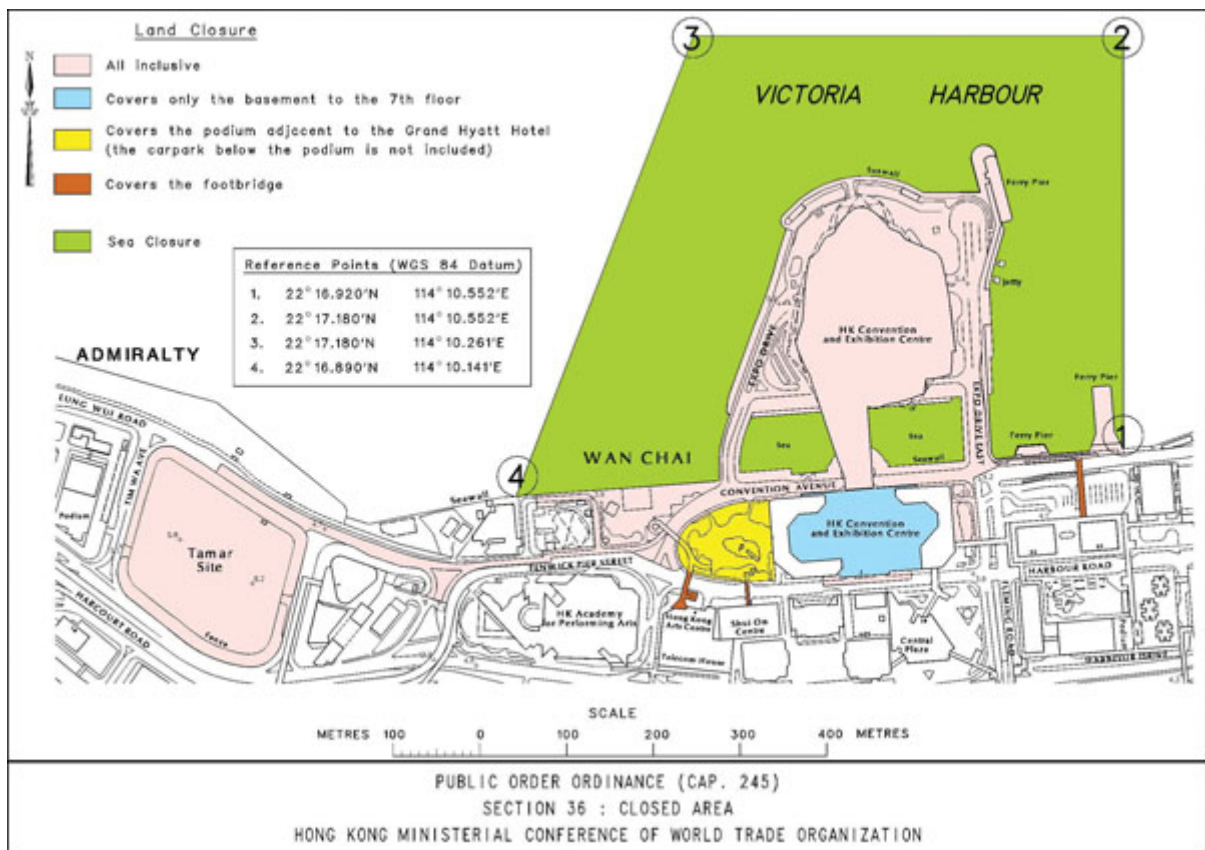





Special Traffic and Transport Arrangements during World Trade Organisation Hong Kong Ministerial Conference December 13 - 18, 2005



During the WTO's Sixth Ministerial Conference (MC6) period, a series of special arrangements will be implemented.

ROAD CLOSURES

From 1800 hours on December 12 (Monday) to 0500 hours on December 19, 2005 (Monday), the following roads within the Closed Area (pink area) are closed to all traffic except with permission from the police :

- Roads north of Convention Avenue & Convention Avenue (section between Fenwick Pier Street and Expo Drive East)
- Harbour Road (eastbound outside HKCEC)
- Fenwick Pier Street (eastbound)
- Lung King Street & Lung Wui Road westbound (sections between Fenwick Pier Street and Tim Wa Avenue)

FERRY SERVICES

- The ferry services at Wan Chai Ferry Pier to Tsim Sha Tsui and Hung Hom will be suspended.
- Passengers on these two routes can make use of the following ferry services and change for other public transport:
 - Tsim Sha Tsui - Central
 - Hung Hom - Central
 - Hung Hom - North Point

CROSS-BOUNDARY COACH SERVICES

- The terminus of the cross-boundary coach service between Wan Chai and Huanggang at Wan Chai North will be suspended and relocated to Central (Macau Ferry) Bus Terminus.

TAXI SERVICES

- The taxi stands at Expo Drive East, Wan Chai Ferry Pier Public Transport Interchange and Harbour Road will be suspended.
- The taxi stands at Lockhart Road will be suspended during public processions.

GREEN MINIBUS SERVICES

BUS SERVICES

- The bus termini outside the Golden Bauhinia Square and Great Eagle Centre, as well as the en-route bus stops on Convention Avenue and Harbour Road will be suspended.
 - 13 routes will be diverted to stop at Gloucester Road outside/opposite Immigration Tower. They are route nos.:

 - 15 routes will be diverted from Wan Chai North to stop at Hennessy Road near Stewart Road/Fleming Road. They are route nos.:

- Cross-harbour route no. 117 will proceed directly to Cross Harbour Tunnel from Canal Road West.

PARKING METERS

- Metered parking spaces on the following roads will be suspended and the time periods will be specified by the notices on site:
 - All roads in Wan Chai North (including Expo Drive East, Lung King Street and Hung Hing

- The following green minibus stands will be relocated to Inner Gloucester Road (west of Cannon Street) during public processions :
 - Routes 4C and 5 at Lockhart Road.
 - Route 4A at Cannon Street; and
 - Routes 10, 11 and 31 at Jaffe Road.

RED MINIBUS SERVICES

- The red minibus stands at Lockhart Road will be suspended during public processions.

PEDESTRIAN ZONES

- The following pedestrian zones will be temporarily rescinded from 1200 hours on December 11, to 0000 hours on December 18, 2005:
 - Lockhart Road (east of Cannon Street), East Point Road and Great George Street; and
 - Pak Sha Road and Lee Garden Road.

TIPS

Throughout the MC6 period, we appeal for your cooperation and patience to put up with any inconvenience caused by special traffic and transport arrangements. We have the following 5 points of advice to the motorists and the commuters:

- 1 Avoid traveling to the affected/congested areas, especially Wan Chai North, unless really necessary;
- 2 Use public transport where possible;
- 3 Avoid driving through the Cross Harbour Tunnel as far as practicable;
- 4 Plan your routes early, use alternative routes and allow more traveling time to cater for unexpected delay;
and
- 5 Watch out for the news from Transport Department via media.

Attention: Depending on the prevailing circumstances and traffic conditions, other ad hoc traffic and transport arrangements, including closure of roads, traffic diversions and suspension, diversion and termination of public transport services, may be introduced during the Ministerial Conference.
