

L.N. 28 of 2006**VILLAGE REPRESENTATIVE ELECTION ORDINANCE
(AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES) ORDER 2006**

(Made by the Secretary for Home Affairs under section 67 of the Village Representative Election Ordinance (Cap. 576))

1. Commencement

This Order shall come into operation on 28 April 2006.

2. Existing Village

(1) Schedule 1 to the Village Representative Election Ordinance (Cap. 576) is amended—

(a) in the English text, in column 1 of item 208, by repealing “Pei” and substituting “Pai”;

(b) in the Chinese text, in column 1 of item 422, by repealing “Pei” and substituting “Pai”.

(2) Schedule 1 is amended—

(a) in the English text, in column 1 of item 388, by repealing “Lei” and substituting “Lee”;

(b) in the Chinese text, in column 1 of item 274, by repealing “Lei” and substituting “Lee”.

(3) Schedule 1 is amended—

(a) in the English text, in column 1 of item 430, by repealing “Sz” and substituting “Sze”;

(b) in the Chinese text, in column 1 of item 395, by repealing “Sz” and substituting “Sze”.

(4) Schedule 1 is amended—

(a) in the English text, in column 1 of item 549, by repealing “環” and substituting “灣”;

(b) in the Chinese text, in column 1 of item 177, by repealing “環” and substituting “灣”.

3. Indigenous Village

(1) Schedule 2 is amended—

- (a) in the English text, in column 1 of item 183, by repealing “Pei” and substituting “Pai”;
 - (b) in the Chinese text, in column 1 of item 353, by repealing “Pei” and substituting “Pai”.
- (2) Schedule 2 is amended—
- (a) in the English text, in column 1 of item 363, by repealing “Sz” and substituting “Sze”;
 - (b) in the Chinese text, in column 1 of item 333, by repealing “Sz” and substituting “Sze”.
- (3) Schedule 2 is amended—
- (a) in the English text, in column 1 of item 464, by repealing “環” and substituting “灣”;
 - (b) in the Chinese text, in column 1 of item 156, by repealing “環” and substituting “灣”.

4. Composite Indigenous Village

Schedule 3 is amended—

- (a) in the English text, in item 10, by repealing “Lei” where it twice appears and substituting “Lee”;
- (b) in the Chinese text, in item 6, by repealing “Lei” where it twice appears and substituting “Lee”.
