

L.N. 219 of 2005**DESIGNATION OF LIBRARIES (NO. 2) ORDER 2005**

(Made by the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services under section 105K of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

1. Cessation of designation as library

The ground floor of No. 9 and 9A, Tit Shu Street, Tai Kok Tsui, Kowloon ceases to be designated as a library.

2. Designation of library

The third floor, Tai Kok Tsui Municipal Services Building, 63 Fuk Tsun Street, Tai Kok Tsui, Kowloon is designated as a library.

3. Schedule amended

The Schedule to the Designation of Libraries Order (Cap. 132 sub. leg. O) is amended by repealing item 28 and substituting—

“28. The third floor, Tai Kok Tsui Municipal Services Building, 63 Fuk Tsun Street, Tai Kok Tsui, Kowloon.”.

Explanatory Note

This Order is made as a result of the relocation of the Tai Kok Tsui Public Library. It cancels the designation of the existing Tai Kok Tsui Public Library at the ground floor of No. 9 and 9A, Tit Shu Street, Tai Kok Tsui, Kowloon and designates the third floor, Tai Kok Tsui Municipal Services Building, 63 Fuk Tsun Street, Tai Kok Tsui, Kowloon, to which that Library is to be relocated, as a library.

2. The effect of this Order is to vest the management and control of the new Tai Kok Tsui Public Library in the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services. It also enables him to exercise his other statutory functions under the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) in respect of that library.
