

L.N. 223 of 2005**PUBLIC HEALTH AND MUNICIPAL SERVICES
ORDINANCE (AMENDMENT OF FOURTH
SCHEDULE) (NO. 3) ORDER 2005**

(Made by the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services under section 106(6) of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132))

1. Public pleasure grounds

(1) The Fourth Schedule to the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) is amended, in the list of public pleasure grounds (other than bathing beaches) under the heading “The Island of Hong Kong”, by adding “Stanley Sports Centre”.

(2) The Fourth Schedule is amended, in the list of public pleasure grounds (other than bathing beaches) under the heading “Kowloon”—

(a) by adding “Carmel Village Street Garden”;

(b) by repealing “Waterloo Road/Wylie Road Garden”;

(c) by repealing “West Kowloon Temporary Waterfront Promenade” and substituting “West Kowloon Waterfront Promenade”.

(3) The Fourth Schedule is amended, in the list of public pleasure grounds (other than bathing beaches) under the heading “The New Territories”—

(a) by repealing “Cheung Chau Tung Wan Children’s Playground” and substituting “Windsurfing Memorial Garden”;

(b) by repealing “Tin Liu Children’s Playground”;

(c) by repealing “Tuen Mun San Hui Market Roof-top Playground”.
