

**Bills Committee on
Energy Efficiency (Labelling of Products) Bill**

**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion
at the meeting on 15 May 2007**

- (1) To provide the latest information on the electricity consumption and penetration rates of the 18 types of energy consuming products under the voluntary Energy Efficiency Labelling Scheme (EELS).
- (2) To initiate the consultation process with the trades regarding the priority of and the time frame within which the remaining 15 products under the voluntary EELS should be included in the second phase of the mandatory EELS. To also consider introducing a similar mandatory scheme for energy efficiency measures in non-domestic energy consuming products.
- (3) To advise overseas experience, particularly the approach adopted and the difficulties encountered, on the implementation of mandatory EELS.
- (4) To advise the annual electricity consumption in the commercial and residential sectors. To also advise the difference in electricity consumption between a residential premises and a commercial premises of the same size.
- (5) To advise the compliance rate of the Building Energy Codes by commercial buildings.
- (6) To provide information on the use of heat engines in promoting energy efficiency in Hong Kong.
