

**Bills Committee on
Energy Efficiency (Labelling of Products) Bill**

**List of follow-up actions arising from the discussion
at the meeting on 21 June 2007**

- (1) To provide an updated progress report on the incentives schemes to encourage replacement of more polluting vehicles, including the provision of tax concession to promote the use of environment friendly cars and a one-off grant to encourage early replacement of pre-Euro and Euro I diesel commercial vehicles with Euro IV vehicles.
- (2) To consider including in the proposed Product Eco-responsibility Bill a mandatory recovery mechanism for used compact fluorescent lamps to ensure proper treatment of the toxic mercury content before disposal.
- (3) To start stepping up public education and publicity on the use of energy-efficient products before passage of the Bill.
- (4) To consider turning the existing voluntary Building Energy Codes into mandatory requirements.
