## **I. Meeting with the Administration**

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration -

- (a) to explain the regulation of oyster rafts in the waters under the Shenzhen Bay Bridge;
- (b) to explain the rescue operations and process in the event that a vehicle fell from the Shenzhen section of the Shenzhen Bay Bridge within the Hong Kong Port Area (HKPA) into the waters;
- (c) to consider extending the standing permission referred to in paragraph 4 of the Administration's paper entitled "Emergency Rescue Arrangement" to rescue operations in the waters near the Shenzhen section of the Shenzhen Bay Bridge within HKPA; and
- (d) to provide, before the visit to the proposed HKPA in Shenzhen Bay Port, details of the complementary public transport services to be provided at each side of the control point and explain how the area in the public transport interchange in HKPA would be utilised.

3. The Administration advised that it would, when determining the operational details of the passenger and vehicle clearance areas in HKPA, consider the suggestion of indicating the demarcation of the Hong Kong and Shenzhen Port Areas boundary.

## **II. Date of next meeting**

4. The Bills Committee noted that the next meeting would be held on 12 March 2007 at 4:30 pm to continue discussion with the Administration.

5. The Bills Committee agreed that a visit would be made to the proposed HKPA in Shenzhen Bay Port in the morning of 17 March 2007. The Bills Committee also agreed that members of the Panel on Security and Panel on

Transport would be invited to join the visit. The Bills Committee suggested that the visit should cover the passenger and vehicle clearance areas, the public transport interchange, the Shenzhen Bay Bridge and an explanation of emergency rescue operations.

6. The meeting ended at 10:25 am.
