I. Meeting with the Administration

The Bills Committee deliberated (index of proceedings attached at **Annex**).

2. The Bills Committee requested the Administration to expedite its discussions with the franchisee of Route 3 on the rationalisation of the utilisation of Route 3 and Tuen Mun Road, consider allowing non-franchised buses to access the Hong Kong Port Area and report back to the Panel on Transport at its meeting on 27 April 2007.

3. The Bills Committee requested the Legal Service Division to provide a paper on whether the Decision of the Standing Committee of the Tenth National People's Congress made on 31 October 2006 was a national law to be applied in the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region under Article 18 of the Basic Law.

II. Date of next meeting

4. The Bills Committee noted that the next meeting would be held on 2 April 2007 at 4:30 pm to continue discussion with the Administration. The Bills Committee agreed that a further meeting would be held on 11 April 2007 at 2:30 pm to discuss insurance-related issues with the Administration.

5. The Bills Committee noted that the Administration intended to resume the Second Reading debate on the Bill at the Council meeting on 25 April 2007. The Bills Committee raised no objection to the resumption date proposed by the Administration.
