The Bills were read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading pursuant to Rule 53(3) of the Rules of Procedure.

Second Reading

Attachment of Income Order (Application to Government and Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2007

The Secretary for Home Affairs moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes (Amendment) Bill 2007

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Domestic Violence (Amendment) Bill 2007

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food moved the Second Reading and addressed the Council.

Question on the Second Reading proposed. The President stated that in accordance with Rule 54(4) of the Rules of Procedure, the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Copyright (Amendment) Bill 2006

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which was moved on 29 March 2006 resumed.

Hon SIN Chung-kai, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Copyright (Amendment) Bill 2006, addressed the Council on the Committee's Report. He then spoke on the Bill in his personal capacity as a Member.

While Hon SIN Chung-kai was speaking, the President left the chair at 1:26 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Seven other Members spoke on the Bill.

After declaring that she was a Councillor of the Hong Kong Intellectual Property Society, Hon Mrs Selina CHOW spoke on the Bill.

Another Member and Hon Albert Jinghan CHENG spoke on the Bill.

While Hon Albert Jinghan CHENG was speaking, Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah requested Hon Albert Jinghan CHENG to elucidate a point about him. He responded that he had nothing to elucidate and withdrew the mentioning of Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah's name in his speech.

With the permission of the President's Deputy, Hon Ronny TONG Ka-wah clarified a point made by Hon Albert Jinghan CHENG, and then spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology replied.

At 3:18 pm, while the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Question on the Second Reading put.

Hon Albert Jinghan CHENG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that 49 Members were present, 47 were in favour of the motion and one against it. (Voting record in Appendix I.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of the Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Copyright (Amendment) Bill 2006**.

Question that clauses 1, 6, 9, 10, 21, 23, 25, 26, 28, 29, 30, 33, 36, 38 to 43, 46, 54, 58, 59, 60, 62, 63 and 64 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 2 to 5, 7, 8, 11 to 20, 22, 24, 27, 31, 32, 34, 35, 37, 44, 45, 47 to 53, 55, 56, 57 and 61 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology moved the deletion of clauses 14 and 50 and amendments to the other aforesaid clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

The Chairman stated that as the amendments to clauses 14 and 50, which dealt with deletion, had been passed, clauses 14 and 50 were therefore deleted from the Bill.

Question that clauses 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 15 to 20, 22, 24, 31, 32, 34, 35, 37, 44, 45, 47, 48, 49, 51, 52, 53, 55, 56, 57 and 61, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Hon Margaret NG moved further amendments to clauses 2 and 27, and addressed the Committee.

One Member spoke on the amendments.

Hon Margaret NG and the Member who had spoken spoke again.

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology spoke on the amendments.

Hon Margaret NG spoke again.

Question on the amendments moved by Hon Margaret NG put.

Hon Margaret NG claimed a division. The Chairman then ordered the Committee to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The Chairman announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 25 were present, five were in favour of the amendments and 20 against them; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 20 were present, 10 were in favour of the amendments and nine against them. (Voting record in Appendix II.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendments were negatived.

Question that clauses 2 and 27, as amended earlier by the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

New clauses 2A, 2B, 16A, 16B, 18A, 18B, 18C, 18D, 20A, 20B, 34A, 34B, 34C, 46A, 51A and 60A read the first time.

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology moved the Second Reading of the aforesaid new clauses and addressed the Committee.

Question on the Second Reading of the aforesaid new clauses proposed, put and agreed to.

New clauses 2A, 2B, 16A, 16B, 18A, 18B, 18C, 18D, 20A, 20B, 34A, 34B, 34C, 46A, 51A and 60A read the second time.

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology moved the addition of the aforesaid new clauses to the Bill.

Question on the addition proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology reported that

the **Copyright (Amendment) Bill 2006**

had passed through the Committee with amendments. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Tsing Sha Control Area Bill

Resumption of Second Reading debate

The debate on the Second Reading which was moved on 18 April 2007 resumed.

Hon LAU Kong-wah, Chairman of the Bills Committee on Tsing Sha Control Area Bill, addressed the Council on the Committee's Report.

One Member spoke on the Bill.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works replied.

Question on the Second Reading put and agreed to.

Bill read the second time and committed to a Committee of the whole Council.

Committee Stage

The Council went into Committee and considered the **Tsing Sha Control Area Bill**.

Question that clauses 3 to 31 stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1 and 2 stand part of the Bill proposed.

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works moved amendments to clauses 1 and 2 and addressed the Committee.

Question on the amendments put and agreed to.

Question that clauses 1 and 2, as amended, stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

Question that Schedule stand part of the Bill proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed.

Third Reading

The Secretary for the Environment, Transport and Works reported that

the Tsing Sha Control Area Bill

had passed through the Committee with amendments. He moved that the Bill be read the third time and do pass.

Question on the Third Reading proposed, put and agreed to.

Bill read the third time and passed.

Motions

Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance

The Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology moved the motion in Appendix III and addressed the Council.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Proposed resolution under the Pharmacy and Poisons Ordinance

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

RESOLVED that the following Regulations, made by the Pharmacy and Poisons Board on 5 June 2007, be approved -

- (a) the Pharmacy and Poisons (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulation 2007; and
- (b) the Poisons List (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulation 2007.

Question on the motion proposed, put and agreed to.

Members' Motions

**Proposed resolution under the Interpretation and General
Clauses Ordinance**

Hon James TO moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

RESOLVED that the Shenzhen Bay Port Hong Kong Port Area (Permission to Enter) Notice, published in the Gazette as Legal Notice No. 75 of 2007 and laid on the table of the Legislative Council on 9 May 2007, be amended, in the Schedule -

- (a) in column 3 of items 1(b), 2(a)(ii) and (b), 3(a)(ii) and (b) and 5, by adding "without reasonable excuse," after "leave" wherever it appears;
- (b) by renumbering items 3, 4 and 5 as items 4, 5 and 6;
- (c) by adding -

"3. Persons being in the Closed Area after entering Hong Kong via the Passenger Terminal Building, for the sole purpose of returning to Shenzhen. The person shall leave the Closed Area without undue delay."

Question on the motion proposed.

Hon LAU Kong-wah spoke on the motion as Chairman of the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Shenzhen Bay Port Hong Kong Port Area, and then in his personal capacity as a Member.

One other Member and the Secretary for Security spoke on the motion.

Hon James TO replied.

Question on the motion put.

Hon James TO claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 23 were present, six were in favour of the motion and 17 against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 18 were present, nine were in favour of the motion and eight against it. (Voting record in Appendix IV.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was negatived.

Elderly in poverty

Hon Frederick FUNG moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That this Council endorses the Report on Elderly in Poverty by the Subcommittee to Study the Subject of Combating Poverty and urges the Government to implement the recommendations therein.

Question on Hon Frederick FUNG's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon Mrs Selina CHOW would move an amendment to the motion. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendment would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW moved the following amendment to Hon Frederick FUNG's motion and addressed the Council:

To add "based on the principle of helping those who are genuinely in need, and not to consider the following three recommendations: (a) reviewing and relaxing the requirement for elders to apply for Comprehensive Social Security Allowance on a household basis; (b) reviewing the arrangement for offsetting the long service payment or severance payment by the accrued benefits derived from the contribution of the employers made to his/her employees in the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes; and (c) considering providing a universal retirement protection for the elderly" immediately before the full stop.

While Hon Mrs Selina CHOW was addressing the Council, the President left the chair at 6:04 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

Question on Hon Mrs Selina CHOW's amendment to Hon Frederick FUNG's motion proposed.

11 Members and Hon LEE Cheuk-yan spoke on the motion and the amendment.

With the permission of the President's Deputy, Hon James TIEN elucidated on a point he had made earlier which he considered to be misunderstood by Hon LEE Cheuk-yan.

Hon Jeffrey LAM Kin-fung spoke on the motion and the amendment.

While Hon Jeffrey LAM Kin-fung was speaking, Hon LEE Cheuk-yan indicated his intention to seek elucidation. Yet Hon Jeffrey LAM Kin-fung did not give way and continued with his speech.

Dr Hon Fernando CHEUNG spoke on the motion and amendment.

At 7:40 pm, while Dr Hon Fernando CHEUNG was speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Another five Members spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Hon Frederick FUNG spoke on the amendment.

The Secretary for Health, Welfare and Food spoke on the motion and the amendment.

Question on Hon Mrs Selina CHOW's amendment to Hon Frederick FUNG's motion put.

Hon Frederick FUNG claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 15 were present, six were in favour of the amendment and nine against it; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 16 were present, one was in favour of the amendment and 14 against it. (Voting record in Appendix V.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Frederick FUNG replied.

Question on Hon Frederick FUNG's motion put.

Hon Mrs Selina CHOW claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 15 were present and 15 were in favour of the motion; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 16 were present and 15 were in favour of the motion. (Voting record in Appendix VI.) Since the question was agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the motion was carried.

Lowering the Mandatory Provident Fund management fees

Hon Miriam LAU moved the following motion and addressed the Council:

That, in view of the relatively high management fees charged under the Mandatory Provident Fund (MPF) schemes and their less than satisfactory investment returns, this Council urges the Government to immediately adopt relevant measures and create favourable conditions to promote competition in the MPF management market, thereby effectively lowering the management fees of the MPF schemes, and appropriately increase the variety and flexibility of their investments as well as strengthen the monitoring of their investment performance, with a view to preventing the erosion of the hard-earned money contributed to the MPF by both employees and employers, and enhancing the effectiveness of the MPF in providing protection to employees' retirement life.

Question on Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed.

The President stated that Hon SIN Chung-kai, Hon CHAN Kam-lam and Hon WONG Kwok-hing would move amendments to the motion. Also, Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen and Hon Jeffrey LAM Kin-fung would move amendments to Hon SIN Chung-kai's and Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendments respectively. In accordance with the Rules of Procedure, the motion and the amendments would be debated together in a joint debate.

Hon SIN Chung-kai, Hon CHAN Kam-lam, Hon WONG Kwok-hing, Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen and Hon Jeffrey LAM Kin-fung spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Three other Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

After declaring that she was as a member of the Management Board of the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority, Hon LI Fung-ying spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Three more Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

After declaring that he was a non-executive director of the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Authority, Hon WONG Ting-kwong spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Three more members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

After declaring his interest that the company which he worked for had financial interests in one of the major Mandatory Provident Fund service providers in Hong Kong, Hon Bernard CHAN spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Another Member and Hon James TIEN spoke on the motion and the amendments.

With the President's permission, Hon Albert CHAN elucidated on a point he had made earlier which he considered to be misunderstood by Hon James TIEN.

Two more Members spoke on the motion and the amendments.

Hon Miriam LAU spoke on the amendments.

The Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury spoke on the motion and the amendments.

While the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury was speaking, the President left the chair at 11:37 pm temporarily and the President's Deputy, Hon Miriam LAU, took the chair.

At 11:39 pm, while the Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury was still speaking, the President resumed the chair.

Hon SIN Chung-kai moved the following amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion:

To add "current" after "in view of the"; to add ", including changing the practice of employers selecting the MPF trustees to allowing employees to choose their own MPF trustees, and adding new provisions to the Code on Disclosure for MPF Investment Funds to require MPF trustees to further disclose the levels of fees and charges for constituent funds of a similar nature, so as" after "create favourable conditions"; and to add "and facilitate comparison by employees participating in the MPF schemes" after "competition in the MPF management market".

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion proposed.

Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen moved the following amendment to Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment:

To add "for their own contributions" after "choose their own MPF trustees"; to add "various" after "the levels of fees and charges for"; and to delete "of a similar nature" after "constituent funds".

Question on Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen's amendment to Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment proposed, put and agreed to.

Question on Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment, as amended by Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen, to Hon Miriam LAU's motion put and agreed to.

The President stated that Hon CHAN Kam-lam had indicated that he would withdraw his amendment if Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment was agreed. Hon CHAN Kam-lam had therefore withdrawn his amendment. Hon Jeffrey LAM Kin-fung therefore might not move his amendment to Hon CHAN Kam-lam's amendment.

As Hon SIN Chung-kai's amendment, as amended by Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen, had been agreed, the President granted leave for Hon WONG Kwok-hing to revise the terms of his amendment and explain them to the Council.

Hon WONG Kwok-hing moved the following further amendment to Hon Hon Miriam LAU's motion as amended by Hon SIN Chung-kai and Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen and explained the revised terms of his amendment to the Council:

To add "; in addition, the Government should study the establishment of a central employees management service system to handle centrally the contributions by both employers and employees" after "employees participating in the MPF schemes"; and to add "; if the situation persistently shows no improvement, the authorities should enact legislation to regulate the management and administrative fees charged by the trustee companies" after "investment performance".

Question on Hon WONG Kwok-hing's amendment to Hon Miriam LAU's motion as amended by Hon SIN Chung-kai and Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen proposed and put.

Hon WONG Kwok-hing claimed a division. The President then ordered the Council to proceed to a division under Rule 47(1) of the Rules of Procedure.

The President announced that among the Members returned by functional constituencies, 22 were present, four were in favour of the amendment, 11 against it and seven abstained; while among the Members returned by geographical constituencies through direct elections, 19 were present, five were in favour of the amendment, two against it and 11 abstained. (Voting record in Appendix VII.) Since the question was not agreed by a majority of each of the two groups of Members present, she declared that the amendment was negatived.

Hon Miriam LAU replied.

Question on Hon Miriam LAU's motion as amended by Hon SIN Chung-kai and Hon Andrew LEUNG Kwan-yuen put and agreed to.

Next Meeting

The President declared that the next meeting of the Council would be held on 4 July 2007 at 11:00 am.

The Council was adjourned at 11:58 pm.

INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ORDINANCE

RESOLUTION

(Under section 54A of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1))

RESOLVED that with effect from 1 July 2007 –

- (1) the functions exercisable by the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology by virtue of –
 - (a) the Import and Export (Amendment) Ordinance 2007 (8 of 2007) be transferred to the Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development and, for the purpose of giving full effect to such transfer, that Ordinance be amended in section 2 by repealing “Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology” and substituting “Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development”;
 - (b) the Unsolicited Electronic Messages Ordinance (9 of 2007) be transferred to the Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development and, for the purpose of giving full effect to such transfer, that Ordinance be amended in the following provisions by repealing “Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology” wherever

it appears and substituting “Secretary for
Commerce and Economic Development” –

- (i) section 1(3);
 - (ii) the definition of “Secretary” in section 2(1);
- (2) in addition to and without derogating from section 23 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Ordinance (Cap. 1) –
- (a) anything lawfully done before 1 July 2007 by or in relation to the Secretary for Commerce, Industry and Technology (“former Secretary”) pursuant to or in connection with any function transferred under this Resolution shall on and from that date be regarded, in so far as necessary for the purpose or in consequence of that transfer, as done by or in relation to, as the case may be, the Secretary for Commerce and Economic Development (“new Secretary”);
 - (b) anything that, immediately before 1 July 2007, may be done and is in the process of being done by or in relation to the former Secretary pursuant to or in connection with any function transferred under this Resolution may on and from that date be continued by or in relation to, as the case may be, the new Secretary;
 - (c) anything that, immediately before 1 July 2007, is required to be done and is in the process of being done by or in relation to the former Secretary pursuant to or in connection with any function

transferred under this Resolution shall on and from that date be continued by or in relation to, as the case may be, the new Secretary;

(d) without limiting subparagraphs (a), (b) and (c) –

(i) any document, agreement or arrangement creating or giving rise to legal rights or obligations that –

(A) refers to the former Secretary, or was prepared, made or entered into by the former Secretary on behalf of the Government; and

(B) is in force immediately before, or is to come into force on or after, 1 July 2007,

shall on and from that date be construed, in so far as necessary for the purpose or in consequence of the transfer of functions under this Resolution from the former Secretary to the new Secretary, as if the references to the former Secretary included references to the new Secretary;

(ii) any form that is specified or prescribed before 1 July 2007 for use in connection with any function of the former Secretary that is transferred under this Resolution may on and from that date be used despite the fact that it contains references to the former Secretary, and

those references shall be construed as
references to the new Secretary.
