Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132)
Designation of Museum (Ping Shan Tang Clan Gallery cum Heritage Trail
Visitors Centre) Order (L.N. 53)

This Order designates the Ping Shan Tang Clan Gallery cum Heritage Trail Visitors Centre, Hang Tau Tsuen, Ping Shan, Yuen Long, New Territories as a museum for the purposes of the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132). The effect of the Order is to vest in the Director of Leisure and Cultural Services the management and control of, and the right to provide facilities in, the museum.

Lands Tribunal (Amendment) Rules 2006 (L.N. 281 of 2006)
Lands Tribunal (Amendment) Rules 2006 (Commencement) Notice (L.N. 54)

2. By this Notice, the Chief Justice appoints 30 April 2007 as the day on which the Lands Tribunal (Amendment) Rules 2006 (L.N. 281 of 2006) (the Amendment Rules) will come into operation.

- 3. The main purpose of the Amendment Rules is to amend the Lands Tribunal Rules (Cap. 17 sub. leg. A) to streamline the application procedures for the repossession of premises, expedite the processing of claims in the Lands Tribunal and align the Lands Tribunal with other levels of court as to the practice and procedure relating to the interlocutory procedure and method of service of documents.
- 4. The Amendment Rules were gazetted on 29 December 2006 and considered by the House Committee on 5 January 2007. Members did not raise any queries on the Amendment Rules.
- 5. No difficulties relating to the legal and drafting aspects of the subsidiary legislation reported above have been identified.
