**Meetings with Leaders of Central Government  
visiting Hong Kong**

Thank you for your letter of 24 November to the Chief Executive. He has asked me to reply on his behalf.

The Central People's Government has noted Members' wish to meet with visiting State Leaders in Hong Kong. The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region works closely with the Central People's Government in making preparation for visits of this standing. In drawing up the visit programmes, while we would make proposals for a State Leader to meet with a wide spectrum of people from the community, we also need to take into account various pertinent factors or constraints such as the purpose and duration of the State Leader's visit.

The Chairman of the Standing Committee of the National People's Congress, Mr WU Bangguo, has been invited by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) to visit Hong Kong and
