**Measures to enhance safety of reversing vehicles –  
Review of Road Environment**

At the meeting of the Panel on Transport on 25 May 2007, we reported that the Transport Department had in consultation with the District Councils identified a total of 132 priority road sections for detailed investigations on measures that can be implemented to enhance the safety of reversing vehicles. We also provided a summary on the overall situation and progress of the implementation work in the 18 districts as at end-April 2007.

We undertook to provide a monthly update on the progress of the improvement works on the 132 priority road sections. Further to our report in June, a report summarising the position as at 15 July 2007 is at the **Annex**.
