1. Commencement

This Notice shall come into operation on 29 June 2007.

2. Declaration of historical building

The building known as Chik Kwai Study Hall at Sheung Tsun Lot No. 406 in D.D. 112, Sheung Tsuen, Pat Heung, Yuen Long, New Territories, delineated and shown edged red on the plan marked Plan No. YLM6230 signed and deposited in the Land Registry by the Secretary for Home Affairs, in accordance with section 3(4) of the Ordinance, is declared to be a historical building.
