## **I Election of Chairman**

Mr James TIEN, the member who had the highest precedence in the Council among all members of the Bills Committee, presided over the election of the Chairman of the Bills Committee. He invited nominations for the chairmanship of the Bills Committee.

2. Mr James TIEN was nominated by Mr CHAN Kam-lam and seconded by Mr Andrew LEUNG. Mr TIEN accepted the nomination. As Mr TIEN was nominated, Mr CHAN Kam-lam took over the chair and presided over the election. There being no other nominations, Mr James TIEN was elected the Chairman. Mr TIEN took over the chair.

3. Members agreed that a Deputy Chairman should be elected for the Bills Committee. The Chairman then invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship. Mr CHAN Kam-lam was nominated by the Chairman and seconded by Mr Andrew LEUNG. Mr CHAN accepted the nomination. There being no other nominations, Mr CHAN Kam-lam was elected the Deputy Chairman.

## **II Any other business**

### Invitation for views

4. Members agreed that the Bills Committee should invite deputations (proposed list of invitees at Appendix III to LC Paper CB(1)654/07-08) to submit views on the Bill and to attend a meeting of the Bills Committee to present their views. They also agreed that a general invitation for submissions should be posted on the website of the Legislative Council (LegCo) on the Internet.
