Product Eco-responsibility Bill

Thank you for your letter of 11 April. Our response to your questions is set out below -

- (a) The use of the word "provide" is not restricted to the context of providing a thing or service gratis according to its usual The Admnistration therefore considers that dictionary meaning. a reference to the provision of a plastic shopping bag in the Bill will include a reference to providing it free of charge or at a cost. But for the avoidance of unnecessary arguments on the requirements in the Bill, the Administration may consider proposing a committee stage amendment to make this intention clearer.
- (b) If a prescribed retailer sells, i.e. provides at a cost, plastic shopping bags that do not fall within the exemptions in Schedule 2, he will be required to become a registered retailer and observe all the obligations imposed on him under the Bill.
- (c) If a prescribed retailer provides to his customers some non-exempted plastic shopping bags free of charge and some at a cost, he will be required to become a registered retailer and observe all the obligations imposed on him under the Bill.
